#### Sheets

Sheets to be laid in a broken bond pattern to avoid a sheet build up at overlap. Always start your first row below the gutter, leaving maximum 7cm overhang. Begin the second row with half an ONDULINE EASYLINE sheet (cut lengthwise) and carry on with complete sheets. If a third row is required, start it with a complete sheet.


## Fixing

Sheets must be fixed onto each of their supporting battens by using the nails or screws specially designed for ONDULINE EASYLINE sheets.

Nail sheets at every corrugation at the eaves, overlaps, ridges and either side of the vertical joints - see Fig 1. Nail intermediate purlins as illustrated in Fig 2.

Prevailling win

Lay in opposite direction to the prevailing wind






Minimum 10 cm overlag on the roof ridge

## Maintenance

To ensure a long life the roof should be cleared of leaves and debris and gutters cleaned regularly. Any branches in contact with the roof surface should be removed.

## Technical Note

EASYLINE sheets are not classified to External S.AA fire rating as required in UK Building Regulations for some classes of structure. In these cases they must be fixed on a fully supporting roof deck and the sheets coated with a proprietary AA surface paint treatment applied in accordance with the paint manufacturer's instructions.
